The local Cairns based airline Hinterland Aviation will operate scheduled airline services between Cairns, Kowanyama and Pormpuraaw. Operations over this route will commence immediately once approval is received from the Civil Aviation Safety Authority.

Initially Hinterland Aviation will operate the service to the same frequency and fare structure as previously offered by Skytrans. Hinterland Aviation is working with the Councils of Pormpuraaw and Kowanyama to ensure that the air service meets the needs of these communities. This also includes involving communities in ticket sales and ground handling.

The route will be operated by the modern 12 seat Cessna Grand Caravan aircraft. The Cessna Caravan high wing aircraft is very comfortable being fully air conditioned and equipped with leather seats. This reliability of this aircraft is proven with Hinterland Aviation achieving a 94% on time performance record.
